Facilitating A Your Hope Story Session

Here is the outline of a typical Your Hope Story session, along with some strategic tips for your success:

WELCOME

Be sure to create an environment where participants feel welcomed and safe. Food or coffee are often a good idea. Help facilitate fun, meaningful conversations.

TIP: Take extra time if necessary to make sure everyone learns the names of others in the group.

PLAY VIDEO

The video session is approximately 17 minutes in length.

TIP: All group participants should have the study guide, and a pen. Encourage participants to fill in the blanks, and use the additional space to write other notes or insights.

DISCUSSION

Encourage everyone to turn to the DISCUSSION QUESTIONS in the STUDY GUIDE. Help facilitate and lead a conversation based on these questions.

TIP: INCLUDE EVERYONE. Be sure everyone is included in the discussion. One way to ease not



discussion. One way to ease non-talkers into the



group conversation is to ask them to read the discussion questions.

TIP: LISTEN. Listen to how the discussion is going, not only to know when to ask the next question, but also to know when someone might be a little confused or want to ask a question.

TIP: As the facilitator, you can change directions in the session and respond to an immediate concern. Your primary role is to encourage and help every person in the group to participate.

ACTION LAB

All sessions wrap up with some combination of REVIEW of the Action Lab from last session, or a new ACTION LAB assignment for next session.

See "NOTES ON INDIVIDUAL SESSIONS" on the coming pages for more specifics on the Action Lab for each session.

TIP: Every participant should be encouraged to do the ACTION LAB assignments from each session. Every participant should also be encouraged to pray for the other members of the group, focusing on the areas being discussed in the rescue sessions.

PRAY TOGETHER

The concluding prayer times can be a highly significant part of this journey. Please prioritize. Take your time.



TIP: Consider having a few people pray, with one assigned person to close. Encourage this to be a heartfelt, meaningful time of prayer, commissioning what we learned to the Lord.

GOING DEEPER

As you wrap-up the session, review next steps:

- 1. Complete the ACTION LAB assignments for the next visit.
- 2. Check out GOING DEEPER. Each session has additional video content available, including "full-length" hope stories, and in some cases, additional bonus video content all referenced in the STUDY GUIDE. Also, encourage folks to follow the @YourHopeStory social media links provided.

NOTE: See the coming pages for greater detail on how to wrap-up each individual session.

3 ACTION STEPS FOR YOU, the LEADER, in between sessions

1. PRAY – Make it one of your goals during this study to pray for the members of your group by name every day. Focus your prayer on their experience of



the "Action Labs" and the content of the rescue sessions.



- 2. FACILITATE communication Consider launching a "group chat," via text, What's App, or even email. An ongoing electronic conversation throughout the week can be a great way for a group to keep in touch, motivate, and encourage each other. Plus, your group will be extra encouraged to attend the next group gathering.
- 3. DO THE ACTION LAB Don't miss out on participating yourself in the Action Lab assignments. Leading by example is key.

NOTES ON INDIVIDUAL SESSIONS

The following pages provide important details unique to individual sessions. Look these over AHEAD OF EACH SESSION, to better prepare.



Session One

SET THE TONE for the ACTION LAB.

Your enthusiasm here will help folks realize that the additional effort in between sessions will be very worth it.

Look over Session One ACTION LAB on page 11 of the Study Guide, and help your group recognize what is being asked to prepare for the next session.

SHARE BONUS VIDEO CONTENT

We have provided additional video content, that if there is time, consider showing to the group.

Play a sample of one of the full-length Hope Stories if there is time, such as Emma Mae, or Luciano. Full-Length Hope Stories are available for download at: https://yourhopestory.com/sessionvideos/hope-stories.



Play, bonus video, called:

"That Day, My Situation Was My Assignment."

HIGHLIGHT "Going Deeper" opportunities.

Encourage your group to check these videos out on their own time before you meet again.

CONNECT – Introduce ways to connect throughout the week – @YourHopeStory social media, as well as your own private group chat or email.



Session Two

ALLOW TIME FOR ACTION LAB REVIEW

After a healthy conversation about the content of Session Two, please allow time for ACTION LAB REVIEW. Review "My Most Important Assignment."

INTRODUCE NEW ACTION LAB ASSIGNMENT

Introduce: New Action Lab for Session Two. This features the "3-Open Prayer" worksheet on page 22 of the STUDY GUIDE. Encourage full participation, and let them know you'll review it the next time you meet.

SHARE BONUS VIDEO: One Hope Story not included in the Session Two content is Den. Den has a great story to share. Play Den's Story if you have time.



MORE GOING DEEPER: Encourage folks to check out Going Deeper full-length Hope Stories, social media links, and more.



Session Three

ALLOW TIME FOR ACTION LAB REVIEW

Allow time for the "Action Lab Review" from Session Two, going over the 3-Open Prayer worksheet.

NEW ACTION LAB ASSIGNMENT

This week, we encourage folks to BEGIN to write out their own Hope Story, "The Story Only I Can Tell." Space for this is provided on page 32 of the STUDY GUIDE. As time allows, try to get some feedback with the discussion questions.

Be sure they take time to COMPLETE THIS ACTION LAB assignment before next visit.

ENCOURAGE THE RESCUE JOURNAL

Continue to encourage writing in the RESCUE JOURNAL. This becomes even more critical in the final sessions.

SHARE BONUS VIDEO: One Hope Story not included in the Session Three content is Blake. Blake shares his story as an intellectual, and how Jesus is for academia. If time, share Blake's story.



Another great bonus video is the fulllength version of "If It Weren't For Jesus."

MORE GOING DEEPER: Encourage folks to check out Going Deeper full-length Hope Stories, social media links, and more.



Session Four

ACTION LAB REVIEW

Allow time to review "The Story Only I Can Tell." Invite people to SHARE their Hope Story with the group.

Don't rush this at the very end. This is a very key part of the journey. Facilitate a warm and inviting opportunity for many in the group to share their stories.

COMMISSIONING PRAYER TIME


As instructed in the Study Guide, have a special time of commissioning of these Hope Stories. Ask everyone to hold them up, and facilitate a time of prayer. The idea is that everyone would pray outloud, simultaneously inviting God to use their story to reach many lost hearts to build His Kingdom.

ACTION LAB

Now we are asking folks to share their Hope Story with others. Really encourage folks to take on this exciting challenge.

MORE GOING DEEPER:

Encourage folks to check out Going Deeper full-length Hope Stories, social media links, and more.





Session Five

ACTION LAB REVIEW

Allow time for a conversation about the experience of sharing your Hope Story with someone else.

ACTION LAB

Walk through Session Five Action Lab on Page 51. Help folks own these important steps to grasping "His Story / The Gospel." Includes memorizing, writing out His Story, practice sharing, and more.

SHARE BONUS VIDEO: One Hope Story not included in the Session Five content is Xiaokuai (Cindy). Xiaokuai has a great story to share. Play Xiaokuai's Story in English if you have time.

Also, Ron and Doug have three Bonus videos to go with this session. If time, watch together. Otherwise, encourage folks to check out on their own at YourHopeStory.com.



MORE GOING DEEPER: Encourage folks to check out Going Deeper full-length Hope Stories, bonus video content, social media links, and more.



Session Six

ACTION LAB REVIEW

Be sure to review Session Five Action Lab.

PRACTICE SHARING THE GOSPEL

This is one of the most important steps of the entire journey. As outlined on page 60 and 61 of the Your Hope Story STUDY GUIDE, take time to have folks practice sharing His Story / The Gospel.

Ideally, break your group into triplets. The person sharing, the lost person listening, and the observer. Consider the following:

Allow the sharer approximately four minutes to share with the listener. The listener is allowed to ask some mild questions for clarification. Then, have the observer weigh in with thoughts on the conversation

Then: ROTATE. Repeat this two more times as needed, so everyone has a chance to play each role.

You will find this a stretching, but very rewarding experience. This doesn't have to be perfect, but will give people a great opportunity, in a friendly environment, to practice sharing the Gospel with others.

LIFE-SAVING CARD

Prepare ahead of time, so every person can receive and fill out a Life-Saving Card.





Life-Saving Cards are available for FREE to download at https://yourhopestory.com/store. OR, you can purchase from RHM.

Help folks know the importance of committing to reaching one lost friend or family member for Jesus.

FINAL ACTION LAB

This is the final session, so the Action Lab from here is simply a lifestyle of sharing Jesus with others.

Please look over the four action steps on page 62 of the STUDY GUIDE, and help reinforce these important opportunities.

SPREAD THE WORD: Please be sure to spread the word about Your Hope Story. Please tell other groups within your church, or in your community, about this unique video series.

FINAL GOING DEEPER: Don't miss Hal's special Hope Story (Hal is in his 90s, and still shares Jesus with others!). Plus, a final Bonus Content video, "Breaking through the Blindness."

Encourage folks to take time to watch some or all of the 27 Full-Length Hope Stories.

Plus, Luciano in Spanish, and Xiaokuai in Mandarin!
